

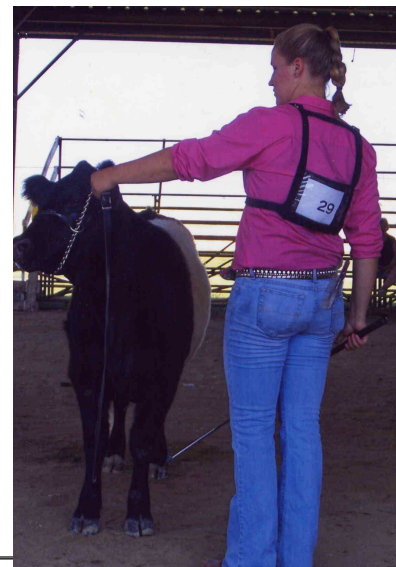
# COMING EVENTS IN 2010
